Postgraduate Diploma in Research Supervision

PURPOSE

The overall purpose of the programme is to contribute to the further professionalisation of academic staff by developing the knowledge, skills, and dispositions required for supervising postgraduate students to successful completion of their studies.

The programme consists of seven modules of which six should be completed for the diploma. They are Postgraduate Research Supervision (compulsory), Academic Literacies in Research Supervision, Research Ethics in Postgraduate Supervision, Assessment of Postgraduate Research, Supervision of Qualitative Research Design, Supervision of Quantitative Research Design, and Current and Emerging Issues in Postgraduate Supervision.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

To gain admission into the Postgraduate Diploma in Research Supervision, an applicant should:

- a) possess at least a Master's degree or equivalent (at NQF level 9) AND
 - b) have had a minimum of two years' experience of at least honours-level research supervision and assessment at the time of registration
- OR
- c) have commensurate appropriate Higher Education experience such as a PhD.

ADDITIONAL SELECTION CRITERIA

Prospective students should provide (a) a written submission outlining work experience; and (b) motivation for entry into the programme.

APPLICATION

Application and important dates

UJ's 2021 application cycle opens on 1 April 2020. The closing date for applications for 2021 is 15 February 2021.

No applications by email or fax are accepted. Applicants wanting to submit a hardcopy application form can submit their application form at any of the four UJ campuses or the application can be sent via post to the university.

REGISTRATION

Once you have applied and been accepted you will still need to register. Registration takes place in January 2021.
